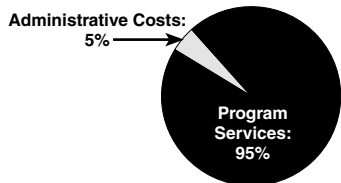


When a project is funded, additional donations fund the most urgent programs for the poor. Contributions are tax-deductible under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).
